

**Minimum Standards
Rules & Regulations:**

Commercial Activity

Any Commercial Operator who is performing a service must furnish insurance to protect the property of Airport and to protect and hold Everett-Stewart Regional Airport, the Owner, and the Commission harmless from any liability in connection with the conduct of the aeronautical activity. Any Commercial Operator must furnish liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000.00 and must maintain a certificate on file in the Manager's Office. The language in this section shall not be construed to impose any liability upon the Owner or the Commission for the activities of any Commercial Operator. The Minimum Standards do not create any agency relationship between the Owner and/or Commission and any Commercial Operator. Each Commercial Operator is engaged in his own business, and the Owner and the Commission have no interest in same. In all policies, the Owner, Everett-Stewart Regional Airport and the Airport Commission shall be named as an additional insured and the owner shall be named as a loss payee.
